



AIRPORT OVERVIEW

As the major air center for the Capital Region, Tech Valley, Northeastern New York and Western New England, the Albany International Airport offers a wide-range of facilities and services. The Airport, located seven miles north of downtown Albany, is accessible via several major interstate and state highways, including I-90 and the Northway (I-87). It is the fourth busiest commercial airport in New York State with an average of 180 daily commercial arrivals and departures.

The Airport opened a completely new terminal in 1998. In quick succession, the terminal was followed by a new parking garage, cargo facility and air traffic control tower. Significant runway extensions were completed in 2003 and 2006. In 2007 the checkpoint was expanded from four to six lanes and CLEAR Registered Traveler Program now operates a registration booth and checkpoint lane. Improvements continue and additional escalators are being added to improve access. General aviation is also expanding with private aircraft and charter operations utilizing the Albany International Airport.

WIFI

Wireless Internet access is available throughout the terminal with two carriers providing service. WiFiFee is a local service provider (www.wififee.com) and Opti-Fi Networks offers national service (www.opti-fi.com). Wi-fi enabled laptops and PDAs will automatically locate the service. Once a Web browser is opened service terms and pricing will be displayed. Hourly, daily and monthly plans are available.

INFORMATION CENTER/AMBASSADORS

The Information Center is open Monday - Friday 6 am to 11 pm and Saturday and Sunday from 7 am to 11 pm. The Information Center provides paging services, flight information, directions, ground transportation, bus tickets and pamphlets for tourist attractions and hotels. In addition, Airport Ambassadors circulate throughout the terminal assisting travelers to locate arrival and departure gates, telephones, baggage claim and ticket areas.

Three conference rooms are available in the Business Center for businesses, individuals or community groups. The largest conference room features video conferencing.
